THREE GENEROUS DONORS AND AN UNDERSTANDING LOCAL AUTO DEALER ENABLE ST. VINCENT DE PAUL REGIONAL SEMINARY TO REPLACE ANTIQUATED VEHICLES

BOYNTON BEACH, FL (December 02, 2007) – The generosity of three donors and a local auto dealership recently came together enabling St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary to replace two aging vehicles with a new 7-passegner van and 5 passenger sedan.

“You might call it an early Christmas present,” said Monsignor Keith R. Brennan, Rector/President of the seminary. “The replaced vehicles were used by our seminarians for transportation to important off campus assignments and other activities. Both were a decade old, in need of costly repairs and not especially fuel efficient.”

“We sought financial assistance from among the many good friends the seminary has and three stepped forward to help,” said Monsignor Brennan. Campus Administrator Keith Parker selected the Hyundai brand and worked with Napleton’s Hyundai of West Palm Beach. “We chose a blue, seven-passenger
